

# HISTOLOGY – Rules and Regulations 2016/17

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Year (US REG/SA programme)

1. Histology course takes 2 semesters (5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>) and includes lectures, seminars and practical classes (labs.).
2. Presence at all the classes is obligatory.
3. Students should be prepared to actively participate in seminars and labs. basing on recommended textbooks (listed on website) and lectures.
4. Every semester is credited on the base of presence and points collected by students during seminars and labs.
5. The points are given for:

Written tests - max. 60 points    5<sup>th</sup> semester - 4 tests (15 questions each)

6<sup>th</sup> semester - 3 tests (20 questions each)

Presentations during seminars - 0, 1, 3, 5 points

At the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> semester student can earn an extra 2 points for the Final Practical Test (2 specimens plus 1 detail in every specimen) – passing level 2 points.

6. To pass the 1<sup>st</sup> semester student should collect minimum 42 points.
7. To pass the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester student should collect minimum 42 points.
8. Student who fails to collect the required number of points still may get the credit for semester. However, she/he will have to pass comprehensive test (covering the material from the whole semester - passing level 50%).
9. **Final Exam** is scheduled at the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester and consists of 2 parts:
  1. Practical - 5 slides + 1 detail in every slide.  
To pass student should recognize minimum 4 slides and 2 details (Those who failed practical test at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester have to recognize minimum 4 slides and 3 details).
  2. Written test - 100 questions ( passing level 70%)Passing of the practical part is required to be admitted to the written one.

### **10. EXAM EXEMPTION**

**To be exempted from the written part of the final exam (MCQ) student has to collect 52 or more points in every semester, pass the practical test at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester and pass the practical part of Final exam (the 1<sup>st</sup> take).**

### **11. During lectures, seminars and labs:**

- Eating, drinking, using of cell phones is absolutely prohibited.
- During labs always wear a lab coat !!
- Leave your warm clothes (coats, hats, scarves etc.) in a cloak-room.
